- 3. Why do we need to be reminded that Jesus loves us enough to lay down his life for us? What makes it hard to believe sometimes?
- 4. What is encouraging about Jesus saying that he has sheep that are not of this fold?
- 5. Jesus clearly invites and commands us to share his love with others but we often struggle to do that. Why do you think that is?
- 6. Thinking about the examples that James offered at the end of the sermon, what is one practical way you could share God's love with someone this week?
