

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Scripture Reference: **Acts 2:14-41**



1. Read through the text (Acts 2:14-41) silently. What stands out to you about what Peter chooses to focus on?
2. What difference does it make if the events in our life are not random or chaotic, but part of a greater story? Is it comforting? Challenging? Confusing?
3. To many of the people in Peter's audience, Jesus is not the kind of King they expected. What are some ways that still might be true today?
4. What helps you to know and believe that Jesus really is the King? Who has helped you see that?
5. The invitation in this passage is to "Repent and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins, and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit." What keeps us from offering that invitation to others? What keeps people from that response?
6. How does the "butterfly effect" of Peter's sermon encourage us to tell friends, neighbors, colleagues, and family members about Jesus?
