Scripture Reference: Acts 4:1-31



Love God in Worship

1. What makes "Gospel Courage" different from other ways we might think about courage?
2. How have you experienced needing courage to be a witness for Jesus? What kinds of challenges keep us from doing this?
3. Why is it significant that in verse 12 Peter says that Jesus is the name by which WE must be saved? How does that demonstrate speaking the truth in love?
4. One of the barriers to speaking the truth in love is that we tend to overemphasize one side of it and neglect the other. Would you say you are more likely to speak the truth harshly, or be loving but ignore the truth?
5. Verse 13 says that the people "recognized that they had been with Jesus." When others look at your life, what might indicate that to them?
6. What is one step you could take towards living with more "Gospel Courage?" It could mean spending more time with him, finding opportunities to be a witness to Jesus, or something else.
