CLOSING POLICY:

If Knox County system is canceled or delayed due to weather, illness, or national security, we will similarly be closed or delayed that day. After a first consecutive missed week of your child's scheduled class days, the Weekday School will make up days from the time forth as Knox County reschedules them. However, Knox County may not make up days on the same day of the week that was originally missed. If they dismiss after school begins that day, we will dismiss as soon as you can get here to pick up your child. Please come as quickly as possible so staff may also pick up their children. Our School Age Care buses will not run after school care if Knox County dismisses early.

Weather closings are announced through Weekday School text alerts and/or school email. The local weather stations have text alerts available from their website to alert of Knox County closings as well.

We do understand these closings can pose an inconvenience to our families. Our Leadership Group (school board) has thoroughly considered other options for closing due to inclement weather but maintains that the safest policy is to close in accordance with Knox County Schools. On average we miss about 6 days per year due to illness/weather closings.

In addition, while we would like to be in a financial position to provide tuition weather credits/refunds, the school's day-to-day expenses, including payroll, continued to be incurred.
