Book of Common Prayer (1552)

For the sake of your Son, Jesus Christ, have mercy on us and forgive us; that we may walk in your ways to the glory of your name. Amen.

Assurance of Pardon

1 John 1:5-9

Leader: This is the message we have heard from him and proclaim to you, that God is light, and in him is no darkness at all. If we say we have fellowship with him while we walk in darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth. But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from all sin. If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
