2. What makes it hard to believe that God could save somebody like Saul? What does that reveal about how we think of ourselves? Others?
3. How does Saul's miraculous conversion remind us that we can't take credit even for our own conversion?
4. Read Acts 9:10-19. What stands out to you about Ananias's role in the story?
5. Who has been an "Ananias" to you? Is there someone who may need you to play that role in their life?
6. What do you think would be a good first step towards developing these kinds of transformational relationships?
7. How does this story highlight the power of Jesus and his grace, and what difference does that make for us today?
