Confession of Sin

Lenten Confession of Sin: Father, we come before you confessing our sin and asking for your mercy. Save us, O God, from the blindness, which is not even aware that it is sinning; From the pride, which cannot admit that it is wrong; From the self-will, which can see nothing but its own way; From the self-righteousness, which can see no flaw within itself: From the callousness, which has sinned so often that it has ceased to care: From the defiance, which is not even sorry for its sins:
