
The next day the large crowd that had come to the feast heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem.





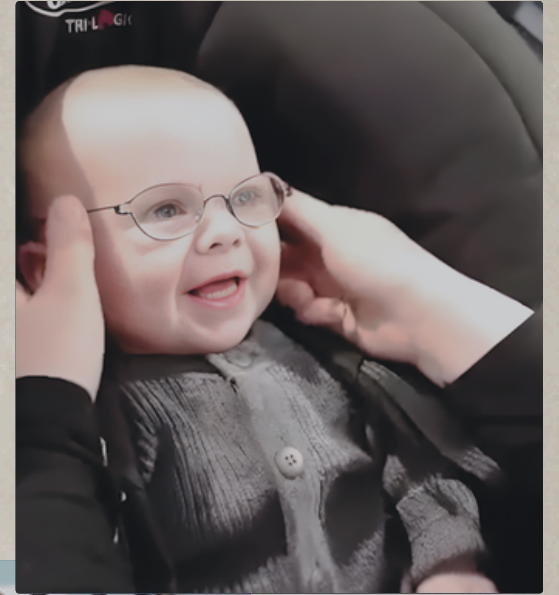
