Frequently Asked Questions

When is Family Vacation Bible School?

Family Vacation Bible School will take place from **Sunday, May 31 - Wednesday, June 3 from 5:45 - 8 PM** in the sanctuary at Cedar Springs. **Please note that registration is required to participate and will be open from April 26 to May 26.**

What is Family Vacation Bible School?

Family Vacation Bible School is an event designed for adults to join along with their children at Vacation Bible School. Parents, grandparents, aunts, uncles, family friends, etc. are invited to participate with their child(ren).

What is the purpose of family-style Vacation Bible School?

Parents play a crucial role as the primary disciple-makers for their children, but many often feel unprepared or unsupported in this vital task. Family Vacation Bible School creates opportunities for meaningful spiritual discussions between children and their parents. It offers a more intentional approach to engaging with those in your community. Additionally, we recognize that parenting can sometimes feel isolating, so we have organized Family Vacation Bible School to help you connect with other parents and families.

Will my children have the chance to socialize with their peers?

Absolutely! Children are encouraged to sit with their friends and move around freely. This year, parents and children will travel together to rooms around the church for fun activities.

What age group can participate?

Family Vacation Bible School is open to all ages. The materials are specifically designed for Kindergarteners up to those entering 6th grade.

I will be joining with my elementary-aged child in the sanctuary. Is there a Vacation Bible School option for my younger child?

Yes, nursery will be available for registration for children from birth to 4 years old.. Your children will have themed VBS activities to do during their time in the Nursery.

What can I expect from my time at Family Vacation Bible School this year?

Each evening, we will kick off in the sanctuary from 5:45 to 6:20 PM. During this time, we'll enjoy songs, dancing, a skit, an introduction to that evening's Bible lesson, a Mascot Moment, and a focus on missions and offering. Following this, families will rotate with their assigned color group through four different stations, which include crafts, games, snacks, and Bible study. We will conclude the evening back in the sanctuary to summarize the evening.

Why is registration necessary?

It's simply to ensure that we have enough materials prepared for the children.

Where should I park and enter the church during the Family Vacation Bible School?

Please make sure to park exclusively in the church parking lots. To enter, use the Welcome Hall doors on the south side of the main building.

We will begin our last night in the sanctuary. Following our group time we will go to the ball field at 6:30 for the end of VBS celebration. Activities will include games, inflatables, face painting, pizza, and a sweet treat.
