5. In being compassionate to the Athenians, Paul has a holy longing for them because he sees them as people who are looking for love, fulfillment, and purpose. How can you be encouraged to be compassionate to those around you by seeing them as people who are longing for something?
6. How is it challenging to be clear in conversations where you feel out of your depth? How can we grow in our ability to be bold in speaking about Jesus without sacrificing the edge of the Gospel?
