DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Has the Possible series changed the way you pray? If so, how? If not, write down or share a way that you've seen God answer your prayers before.
2. The sermon illustration for asking, seeking, and knocking centered around a boy who needs his mother; if she's near, he asks, if she's close by, he seeks, if she's behind a closed door, he knocks. As we start to think about God changing our lives this year, does God feel close to you (close enough to ask), somewhere away but accessible (seek), or behind a closed door (far off, knock)?
3. What are some "no's", "wait's", or "don't know's" that you've received from God regarding your prayers? How might His goodness be shining through in these answers?
4. "God is for you even if you don't know what he's doing in your life." What area in your life do you need a reminder that God is for you?
5. Because of the Gospel, "when the dust settles (on our prayers), not only will God's character be intact, but you will be too." Where in your life do you need this reminder today?
6. We ask again on this last week of the series, what are you asking God to do in your life this year?
